GENERAL INFORMATION

1 DATE & VENUE

1.1 The competition will be held from 25 July – 02 August 2009 at the respective locations:

2 <u>RULES</u>

- 2.1 Pistol, Rifle and Shotgun events will be conducted according to the rules and regulations of the International Shooting Sports Federation (ISSF).
- 2.2 Practical Pistol Combat competition (PPC) will be conducted according to the WA1500 PPC rules (www.wa1500.org/rules.htm) with the following exceptions:
 - a. Open/Speed Holster is allowed for all events and
 - b. Open/Speed Magazine pouches are allowed for all events
 - c. Will apply in-house rules if it is not addressed by WA1500 PPC rules
- 2.3 International Defensive Pistol Association (IDPA) will be conducted according to the rules stated on http://www.idpa-singapore.com/downloads/IDPA-RuleBook-2005.pdf.
- 2.4 IPSC Events will be conducted as per International Practical Shooting Confederation (IPSC) latest edition January 2006 Handgun rules and interpretations (www.ipsc.org)

3 **PRIZES**

- 3.1 Prizes will be awarded to the Top 3 Individuals and Top 3 Teams for each Air Weapons, PPC, IPSC, Sport Pistol, Sport Rifle and Shotgun events (Trap, D/Trap, and Skeet)
- 3.2 To satisfy for a division or a category, a minimum of four individuals or teams is required.
- 3.3 Prizes will also be awarded to Top 3 Teams regardless of Divisions. The Organization reserves the right to change the format of prizes depending on the number of participants in each category.
- 3.4 The prize presentation ceremony will be held after completion of each event at the respective ranges.

4 FOOD & BEVERAGE

4.1 Lunch and refreshment will be provided for all Technical Officials (eg: Jury, Referee & assigned volunteer) on practice and competition days. For participants and Team Officials food and beverage will be on sale daily at the National Shooting Centre and from 0830hrs to 1600hrs.

5 ACCOMMODATION

5.1 The official hotel is Copthorne Orchid Hotel. It is located near the Botanic Gardens; the resort-style Copthorne Orchid Hotel also enjoys proximity to Singapore's most popular shopping district, Orchard Road and late night food hub of Newton Circles. It is accessible to major tourist attractions, as well as the Central Business District and major convention centers

5.2 The rates are inclusive of daily scheduled transportation services between official hotel and range, breakfast, and 10% service charge and prevailing goods and service tax of 7%.

6 FIREARMS & AMMUNITION

- 6.1 Firearms, ammunition and firearm parts are only allowed to be transported in checked baggage. Firearms, ammunition and firearm parts are prohibited from carry-on baggage.
- 6.2 Under the Singapore Arms & Explosives Acts, it is a requirement that clearance of all firearms and ammunitions have to be escorted by police from the aircraft to the custom office upon arrivals and vice versa for departures. Time required for per clearance is minimally 2 hours. Participants will have to bear the cost of airport and airline security charges. There will be a levy surcharge of SGD80.00 per Arrival and SGD80.00 per Departure.
- 6.3 Upon clearance at the Singapore Changi Airport, the firearms and ammunition will be transported directly and stored in the armories at the respective locations:
 - a) Air Weapons SAFRA Air Weapons Shooting Range
 - b) Firearms National Shooting Centre
- 6.4 All participants are advised to pack their air weapons and pellets (if any) separately from firearms due to different storage venue. Do not place any weapon parts, ammunition or pellets in your hand-carry baggage.

- 6.5 Ammunition and targets will be on sale at the ranges. Participants who wish to bring back unused ammunition and/or empty cartridges will have to bear all cost incurred including excess baggage charges. For excess baggage charges, kindly refer to your respective airline.
- 6.6 Please refrain from changing your firearm type, model and serial numbers and ammunitions quantity once you had submitted your firearm and ammunition export and import license application to avoid possible complications.

7 TRANSPORTATION

- 7.1 Transport will be provided for all registered officials, guest and shooting participants to and from Singapore Changi Airport and the official hotel. Transportation will be available between the official hotel and shooting ranges on a daily basis. The transport schedule will be displayed on notice boards at the hotel and shooting ranges. Please adhere strictly to the transport schedule.
- 7.2 Participants who are not residing at the official hotel will have to make and bear their own transport arrangements with advice from our friendly staff.
- 7.3 Officials or participants who wish to travel away from the allocated transport time will have to bear the additional transport cost.
- 7.4 Officials and participants are to present their registration card prior to boarding the official transport. Personnel without the registration card will not be allowed to board the official transport.
